Green Belt

Sevenoaks council has defined this as greenfield 'Green Belt' sites providing social and community infrastructure benefits that addresses genuine needs in the area. I would suggest that the Broke Hill development does not address any genuine needs that exist within the area.

The development does not address any genuine needs that exist within the area. There is nothing suggested in this development that would be of benefit of the existing community. Indeed it would add increased pressure on existing infrastructure creating congestion, increased pollution though traffic fumes and also light and noise pollution. Pressure would be created on the local hospitals. The proposal for a primary school is a blatant ploy to curry favour for no other purpose than to build houses. This is the same techniques that Quinn Estates is using at Broke Hill. There is real danger that the parish of Halstead and the surrounding villages will be buried in brick and concrete.
