T1 Scots Pine:- Reduce main trunk of tree by some 25-30 feet down to a major branch which will be the new re growth point of the tree. Protruding from this major branch is a canopy and the aim is to reduce the canopy by some 1.5-2.0 metres to suitable re growth points on the branch by approved techniques.							
The tree in question is a large Scots Pine that is situated in the side garden where the client lives. The client obviously wants to keep the tree but is under the mpression that the tree has grown far to tall and large for the plot that it is situated in. Looking at the tree it would appear that the only way to reduce the tree down to a more proportionate size would be to reduce the main trunk of the tree down to the major branch that protrudes from it which would then mean that obviously it would not be as tall and a lot of weight would have been taken out of the top of the tree which would make it more sustainable for the client to manage and also by doing this work there would hopefully be many more years of growth in the desired tree.
