Dear Ms Kendell,

I have received the Council's letter regarding a planning proposal at [3 Wellesley Close, Broadstairs CT10 2HH](#). It refers to (sic) 'Erection of a single storey side and rear extensions, together with alterations to fenestration.' Ref:FH/TH/21/0243.

In looking into this online, it appears that an additional application has been made for a 'Granny annexe' at the property but I have had no notification from the Council regarding this. Since it would impact severely on my quiet enjoyment of the garden in my own property, I have strong objections to this.

It is already the case that a so-called 'temporary' building is being used for habitation on the opposite side of Wellesley Close, (with vehicular access from the rear footpath). I consider that to grant permission for the 'Granny annexe' at No. 3 would add to a proliferation of unsightly and ill-designed outbuildings blighting one of the few areas in Broadstairs where gardens offer privacy and space.

You will be better qualified than I to identify additional issues such as noise pollution, property density, emergency access in a very restricted cul-de-sac, et cetera.
