e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

Yew (T1) - Reduce height and crown width by approximately 1.5 metres whilst maintaining the natural shape of the tree. Thin crown by 10% to allow more light to the house

Holly (T2) - Reduce height of tree to approximately 2.5 metres, to where new growth is sprouting. This is due to significant die back on main stem Holly (G1) - Fell dead and dying trees to ground level

Apple (T3) - Fell to ground level due to significant die back
