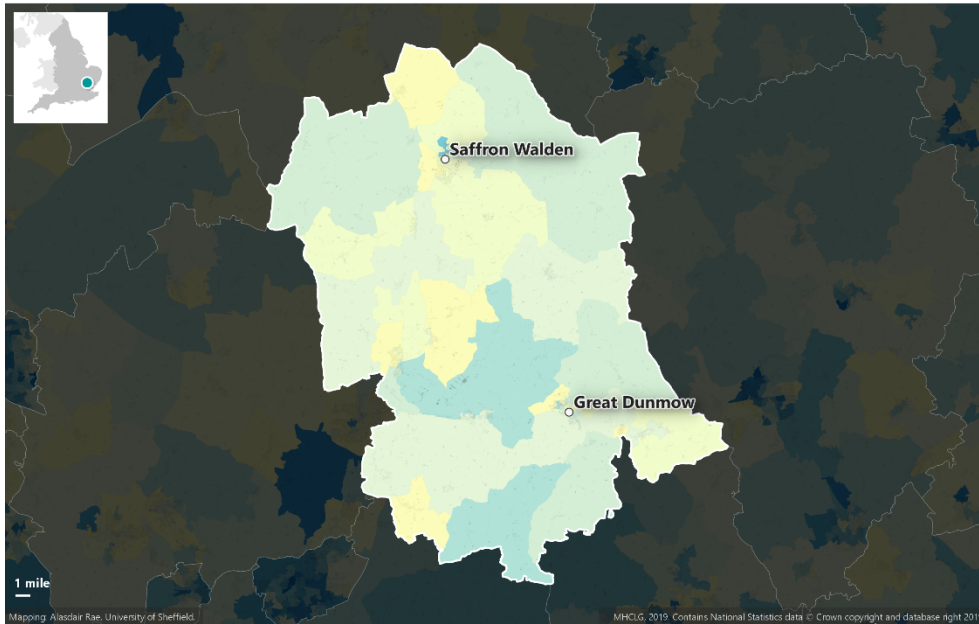


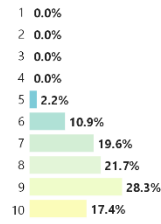

MORE DEPRIVED



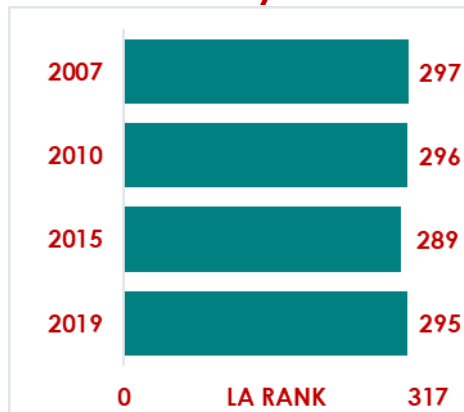

What this map shows

This is a map of Indices of Deprivation 2019 data for Uttlesford. The colours on the map indicate the deprivation decile of each Lower Layer Super Output Area (LSOA) for England as a whole, and the coloured bars above indicate the proportion of LSOAs in each national deprivation decile. The most deprived areas (decile 1) are shown in blue. It is important to keep in mind that the Indices of Deprivation relate to small areas and do not tell us how deprived, or wealthy, individual people are. LSOAs have an average population of just under 1,700 (as of 2017).



Local Authority Rank *

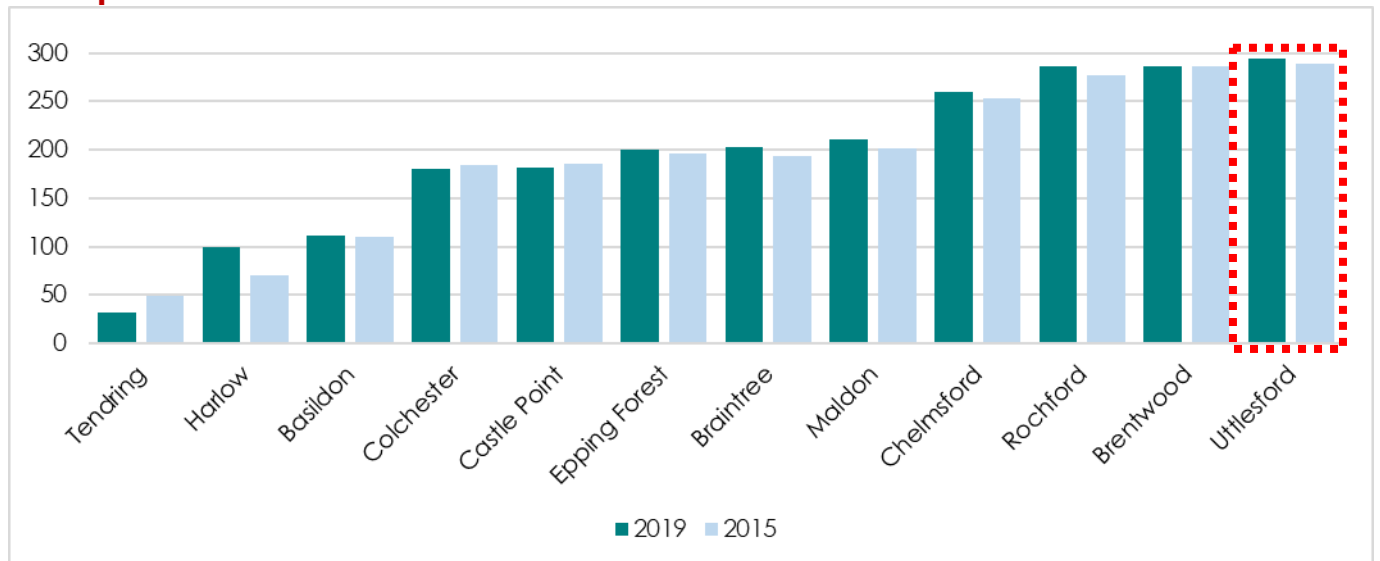


In the Indices of Multiple Deprivation 2019 the Uttlesford Local Authority area was ranked 297 out of 317 lower tier authorities in England based on the average rank of the LSOAs in this area (where 1= most deprived). This places Uttlesford in the upper 10% of least deprived Lower Tier Local Authorities (LTLAs) nationally.



Compared to the IMD 2015 period the average rank of the area has improved (+6 places) and but is the third lowest relative ranking compared to each of the IMD periods.

Comparison with other Essex Lower Tier Local Authorities



Compared to the other local authority areas in Essex, Uttlesford is ranked as the least deprived LA in the county for overall deprivation. Uttlesford is also one of three areas in Essex which fall into the 10% least deprived areas nationally and is one of 9 areas which moved up in their rank of average rank compared to the 2015 IMD period.

* Rankings have been calculated using against the total number of LTLAs as of 2019. As such ranks from previous years may be different than those published in previous IMD reports due to there being fewer LAs overall.

The IMD 2019 shows that Uttlesford has the lowest rank in the Barriers to Housing & Services domain which falls into the 20% most deprived areas nationally whilst all other domains place into the top 40% or higher. The domain which has the highest ranking was the Employment domain where it is placed in the top 10% least deprived areas and was the third highest LA nationally. Compared to the 2015 IMD **3** domains have improved in the national rankings whilst **4** domains + IDACI & IDAOPI have decreased. The biggest positive change was in the Education domain (+9 places), whilst the biggest negative change was in the Living environment domain (-19 places) and moved from decile 8 to decile 7.

LSOAs in Deprivation

As of 2019 the Uttlesford area contains 46 LSOAs of which none are ranked in the bottom two most deprived deciles nationally. Uttlesford is one of three LTLAs across the ECC area which do not have any LSOAs in the bottom 10% nationally.

At the other end of the spectrum Uttlesford was identified as having 21 LSOAs in deciles 9 and 10 (the top 20% least deprived LSOAs nationally). Equivalent to 45.7% of all LSOAs in the Uttlesford area, this is higher than the Essex average of 25.8% and ranks as the 3rd highest proportion out of the 12 Essex Districts.

LSOAs Rank Change

Between 2015 and 2019 no LSOAs in Uttlesford moved into or out of the bottom two most deprived deciles nationally.

Across all deciles a total of 15 LSOAs in the area have declined in their national rank relative to 2015 and 31 have increased. This is equivalent to 33% / 67% of all LSOAs having declined / improved. The percentage of LSOAs which increased their rank in 2019 is 39% higher than 2015 (28%).

In 2019 no Maldon were living in the bottom quintile/20% most deprived areas and is one of 3 LTLAs in Essex which have no residents in these deciles. This has been consistent across all periods from 2007 onwards.

At the other end of the spectrum the area has experienced significant decreases in the number of residents living in the least deprived quintile with 17,159 fewer people and dropping from 78% to 44.8% between 2007 and 2019. As such the areas has gone from having over two thirds of the population in the 20% least deprived areas nationally to less than half in 12 years. Although this area does not currently have any residents in the most deprived areas, this significant reduction in the upper quintile is nether-the-less the biggest drop observed across the county.

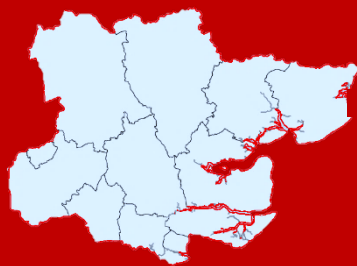
