I would like to seek permission to remove two trees from our garden - a Scott's Pine and a Conifer tree. The former is in a position where we would like to extend our driveway to cater for two cars and its roots are causing significant damage to a listed wall and a walkway we share with our neighbours at 26 Ellis Street. In high winds it also poses a threat to neighbouring cars (one of which narrowly avoided a fallen branch) and houses.					
The latter is blocking light to our garden and our neighbours garden which will pose a bigger problem when we renovate our garden area this summer to plant vegetable plots. Both trees have grown to a height that is now unmanageable and posing multiple problems therefore we would like to remove them both entirely.					
We will however, be planting a number of trees in our garden area to compensate their loss.
