Works to Trees in a Conservation Area

Proposal: T1 - Holly - height 14 meters. Reduce the height by 3 meters and crown raise to 3 meters, T2 - Laurel - height 6 meters spread 8 meters. Reduce to 2.5 meters to create a smaller hedge, T3 - Holly - height 9 meters. Reduce to 2.5 meters to create a smaller hedge and T4 - Laurel - height 3 meters. To remove.
