Alternatively, you can annotate on the location plan which flatted dwelling this application relates to, or fill in Certificate B of the Land Ownership Certificate.
- 2. Please confirm the existing use class of the office (Class 2/Class 4).
- 3. Please submit existing and proposed elevations to a scale of not less than 1:100. Alternatively, please confirm that there will not e any changes to the exterior of the property as a result of the proposed changes.

We will only accept additional information to your application using the Post Submission Additional Documents (PSAD) process. We will no longer accept emails.

Additional information received after 21 days will invalidate any Land Ownership Certificate – if this was completed. This must be dated within 21 days, and is <u>a</u> legislative requirement. Furthermore, any information that is not **submitted** electronically, will also delay your application.
