Introduction

We nurture each child as an individual from the beginning, encouraging them to explore the curiosities that their world presents them with, whilst facilitating new learning experiences from all that surrounds them.

The Canopy Children's Nursery

The vision for Canopy is to disrupt the landscape of childcare provision, giving children the power to change the world in their own unique ways.

This vision will be delivered by getting these 5 core elements right and working together in harmony in our nurseries:

A Child-centred Curriculum

At Canopy we look at the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) through the eyes of the children to develop a truly engaging curriculum. It is a blended approach based on aspects of the Reggio Emilia pedagogy which views young children as individuals who are curious about their world and have the powerful potential to learn from all that surrounds them.

We listen to the children and their families to understand their individual interests and needs. Combined with a knowledge of projects which are known to interest children, we can then plan and deliver a curriculum which follows each child's interests and harnesses their natural curiosity.

The Canopy curriculum builds on the main trunk of the Early Years Foundation Stage with branches to develop every child's skills as:

• Independent learners

Canopy Early Years Curriculum enables
children to follow their own learning adventures
so that they can explore their ideas in their own
way and at their own pace. Canopy Children's
Nurseries encourage children to develop a

sense of independence and make their own choices about how they play.

Inquisitive thinkers

Introducing children to ideas and concepts in lots of different ways gives every child the best chance of understanding and connecting with the curriculum. Canopy Children's Nurseries give children opportunities to ask questions, test out their own way of using open-ended equipment, and explore through physical play, art, music, construction, role play and storytelling.

Curious explorers

Beautifully designed outdoor spaces to allow children every opportunity to develop their natural curiosity and explore outdoors, in all weathers.

• Comfortable engagers

Encouraging children to increasingly collaborate with one another as they get older aids their cognitive development as well as their interpersonal skills. Canopy Children's Nurseries listen carefully to each child to promote a balance between a sense of belonging to the group and a sense of self.

A Talented Team of Practitioners

Recruiting, developing and retaining talented staff practitioners is a priority so that we have a team who are skilled and empowered to follow children's interests and harness their natural curiosity.

Canopy Children's Nurseries encourage a culture of excellence where the team work together to continually improve their skills and expertise to benefit the children in their care.

Canopy Children's Nurseries have HR systems to ensure that staff members feel valued, supported and rewarded in their roles. We work alongside local colleges to support Early Educator Apprenticeships and the vision is to create a Canopy Academy to compliment the Early Years Educator Programme and train our practitioners in the delivery of our unique curriculum.

Partnership with Parents

Building strong relationships with parents where they feel involved and listened to is fundamental to understanding each child and helping them reach their full potential. The natural, informal

communication between parents and staff is supplemented with a system which facilitates ongoing two-way communication via a secure app, providing development reports, child observations, daily diaries and essential messages.





An Enabling Environment

The classroom is often referred to as the "third teacher" and so great care is taken to construct an environment that supports the curriculum and allows for the easy exploration of individual interests.

Canopy Children's Nurseries work with experienced design partners to create a model nursery environment based on:

- A space which is calm, interesting and invites curiosity and exploration
- Furniture which is comfortable and versatile
- Storage which makes resources visible and accessible encouraging independence and allowing children to choose their own play.

Outdoor learning is a big part of the Canopy Early Years Curriculum and each nursery has an outdoor environment that is thoughtfully planned to enable children to thrive by challenging themselves, understand their own limits, be curious and investigate.



In order to thrive, children need to exercise, eat well and sleep well with the support and guidance of caring adults. Canopy Children's Nurseries ensure that during their day with us, children get the chance to:

- Run around outside, get out of breath and be curious
- Sit down together for freshly prepared, organic meals and snacks which suit all dietary requirements and encourage social interactions.
- Relax in a quiet, and comfortable environment so that they can rest/sleep

Franchising

'We only flourish as a whole if you flourish individually.'

According to research, 2 out of 3 people have considered starting their own business.

Owning a franchise enables you to do this with a reduced level of risk and stress.

The benefits of owning a franchise are:

- 1. You trade under an established brand name, giving you a head start at building your business
- 2. It has a track record of business performance, giving you confidence that the business is in demand and profitable
- 3. The brand will have defined its customer base, unique selling proposition and brand values so you can understand why the business is successful and decide whether it appeals to you

Initial Costs

The initial franchise fee of £45k + vat includes:

Property services

All the property services that you require to open your nursery which includes property finding, planning, architectural, interior and exterior design services. We coordinate the services of our external partners and hand the building over to you when it is ready to open.

Marketing

Complete pre-launch Marketing plan and package to include digital Marketing services in conjunction with the website, PR and social media advertising. Full brand guidelines, templates and assets are provided

Operational Support

We provide an operations manual which gives step by step instructions on setting up your nursery as well as tool boxes containing the assets and templates that you will require to complete these steps. We have a team of nursery professionals who will be there to guide and support you throughout the process.

Training

Experienced Early Years consultants and business professionals will take you through a full programme of training modules.

They comprise a mixture of external and internal courses, many of which can be completed on-line.

They will cover the business systems that you will be using to as well as delivery of the Canopy Early Years Curriculum. Training of the nursery practitioner teams is also included.

Technology

Your franchise fee includes the set up and ongoing use of an all-in-one Nursery Learning, Assessment and Management Software system, allowing you to schedule children, manage enquiries and communicate child development and progress reports with parents. This system will be linked to your invoicing and fee collection system to ensure effective financial management.

Total set-up costs

 Children's Nursery will vary according to the exact size, location and nature of the proposed property but are estimated to be approximately £200k which is calculated as follows:

The monthly franchise management fee is 8% of sales turnover + vat.

The costs of setting up and running a Canopy Children's Nursery are significant. Therefore, the rewards for doing this effectively must also be significant, enabling franchisees to earn six figure salaries.

Prospective franchisees will be taken through a full financial model of expected returns at the next stage of the process.

Process

We aim to establish sustainable and successful partnerships with the highest calibre of franchisees so we have a process to follow to ensure that we are a good fit for each other:

1. Discovery Meeting

We invite you to a face-to-face meeting to take you through our ethos and vision for the Canopy Children's Nursery brand, and to explain the franchise system and process in detail. We understand that you want to make a healthy profit in return for your investment and hard work and we will demonstrate how you can achieve this using a financial model based on actual fee income, overheads and expenses to give you a realistic income expectation.

2. Application

If you wish to be considered as a franchisee then you need to complete an Application Form, Business Plan and Psychometric Test. We will complete DBS, Reference & Financial checks and invite you to an interview.

3. Interview

This is a face to face interview with at least 2 of the Directors to ensure that you fully understand your commitment to the process and so that we understand your personality, ambitions and expectations.

4. Intention to Proceed

If we are both happy to proceed then we complete an Intention to Proceed Agreement and an initial deposit of £7,500 will be payable, after which we will start the 'route to opening' process. This will be tailored to your skills, experience and requirements.

The Canopy team will now:

- Assist you with finding the right property and location for your Canopy Children's Nursery
- Introduce you to finance partners if you need to arrange business finance
- Guide you through the legal process and any planning applications required (associated costs to be paid for as incurred by the franchisee)
- Work with our interior design team and affiliated architects to plan your nursery in line with the Canopy brand guidelines
- Apply for your Ofsted licence
- Commence training, coaching and guidance

5. Full Franchise Agreement

Once the property has been secured and the lease agreed, your remaining franchise fee is payable and the Franchise Agreement will be signed by all parties.
