Mountain Ash Sappling (T1) requires removal due to future excessive size and proximity to housing both our house and our neighbours. We have concerns around possible future damage to buildings.

Willow (T2) requires trimming/branch removal due to its size and proximity to housing and two of its branches growing over a public right of way to the rear of the property.
