## Garage Door Installation Application

The purpose of this document is to explain the re-introduction of a pedestrian door into the double garage to enable easy access to the garage without having to enter through the main vehicle doors each time.

The below photo was left to us by the previous owners and is dated November 1972. It shows there used to be a timber door into the gable end of the barn along with a window which was converted into the current property garages (I assume when the adjacent properties were built on the old farm).


The below photos are taken of this same gable end from both inside and outside to show how until recently this door remained in place until someone blocked it up. There is evidence internally of the door opening still being there as only the external skin was bricked up. Both internally and externally you can see the rollock course above the old door. Externally, you can also see a slab footpath from the edge of the gravel drive to the middle of the gable end which would have been a path to the door.


I would like to re-open this door aperture within the external skin of brickwork and reinstall a white, timber hardwood door as the original photo shown. This would both restore this gable end to its original build in appearance along with making the garage more easily accessible. The internal opening size is $2125 \mathrm{~mm} \times 1120 \mathrm{~mm}$ so a bespoke door is required which will be of the system in the below image shows the type of timber door.
