

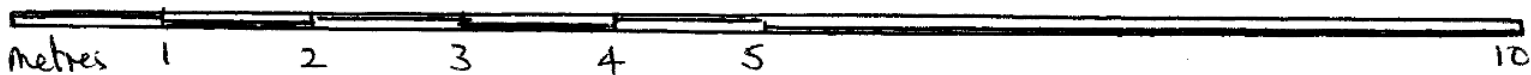
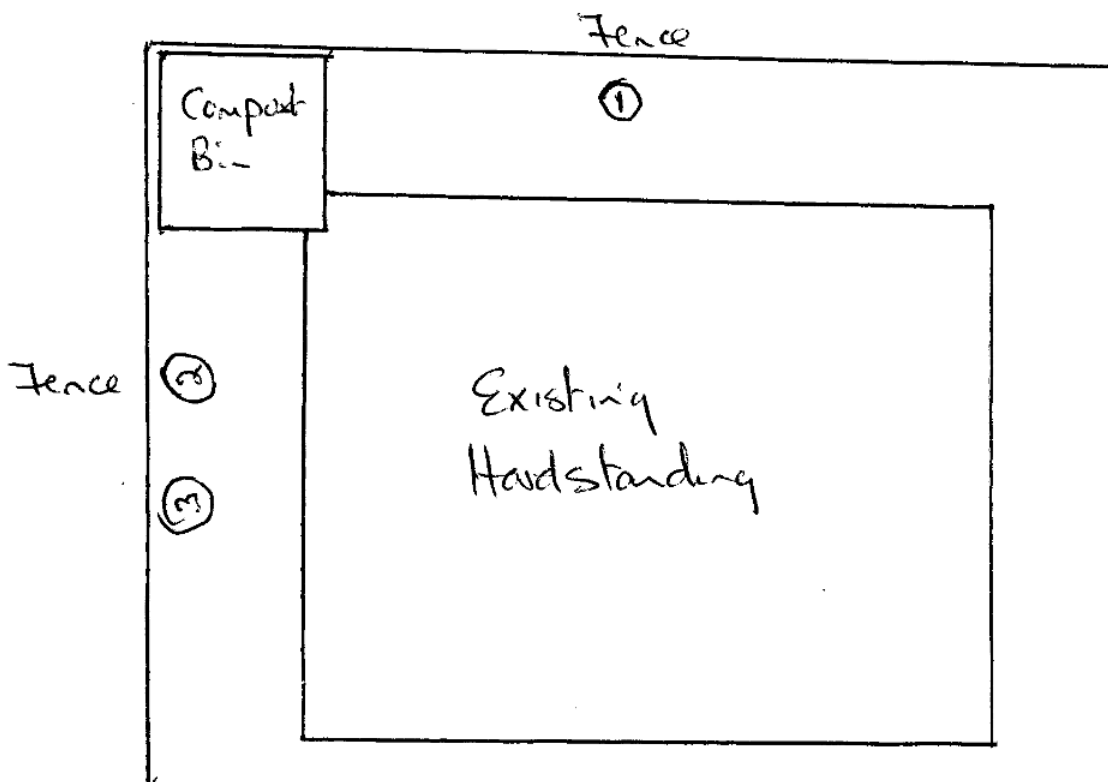
Arboricultural Survey

I have surveyed the trees in the vicinity of the proposed summerhouse.

There are 3 significant trees, as shown on the plan below:-

1. This is a damson tree. The trunk diameter is about 10cm, and it is about 2.5 metre tall.
2. This is a hazel tree. It has twin trunks, with diameters of about 10cm and 12 cm; it is about 3 metres high.
3. This is a pittosporum tree. The trunk diameter is about 20cm and it is about 3 metres high.

They are all sound, healthy, well-established and deep-rooted in clayish soil, so there is not danger that they could fall on the summerhouse. The survived the Great Storm of October 1987, and more recent severe storms. All are showing healthy leaf growth this Spring.
