Ash Tree (T5) - Section fell dead ash tree to ground level, recommended by Aviva Tree Surgeon representative to reduce risk of subsidence.

Oak Tree (not on plan) - Undertake a 15% crown reduction of mature Oak Tree in back garden in order to promote the health of the tree, remove any damaged or dead wood. This work will be undertaken when the tree is dormant in order to minimise stress to the tree.
