Hi Barry

The changes will need to be authorised. For the LBC side, you can apply to vary condition 2 under Section 19 of the Planning (Listed Buildings & Conservation Areas) Act 1990. For the PP, you would need to speak to one of my colleagues in the development team as to whether this would be a 'non-material amendment' or a Section 73 variation of condition.

The rooflights sound ok in principle, but we wouldn't want to see too many on the elevation, as it gives a more domestic character to what is an agricultural building. We also wouldn't support them on the road-facing slopes.
