You may not start work until the end of the statutory six week period unless you receive written permission from the Council's Planning Department (This permission will be issued electronically only if you have provided us with an email address. Details of the decision will also appear on our website upon decision). If you do not hear from the department by **29th June 2021** you can start work from that date. You need to complete the work within two years of having given the notice, otherwise you will need to submit another notice. If you do not own the tree(s) in question you are advised to consult with and where necessary obtain the permission of the owner before you start work.

You should also be aware of government legislation (the Wildlife and Countryside Act) which protects wild birds, animals and plants in the UK. You can find information about your responsibilities on the internet.
