following my visit as requested looking at two trees at your address.

Starting in front garden on righthand side next to parking area there is

(T1) Apple tree: Looking around the base of this tree there are no signs of any fungal fruiting bodies at time of visit. This is a mature tree which is showing poor vitality and preventing other younger fruit trees from developing.

Recommendation:

Is to remove this tree and replace with another tree in a different location within the garden.

Moving along the garden towards house

(T2) Cypress tree: Looking around this multi stemmed tree there are no signs of any fungal fruiting bodies at time of visit.

This is a mature tree which has become too big for its location and proximity to house.

Also, this tree is overhanging public footpath.

Recommendation:

Is to remove this tree and replace it with a more suitable tree in a different location within the address. As other recommendations (ie) reducing this tree in height would leave a poor and unsightly tree.
