
Design and Heritage Statement

Description

7 Gloucester View is a brick built mid-terrace property. This planning application proposes the replacement of the 2 main timber sash windows at the front of the property.

Architectural Character

Gloucester View is situated with the King Street Conservation Area. The conservation comprises a mixture of Victorian period terraces, post-war flats and more recent of modern, mainly terraced housing. Gloucester View is a very attractive terrace of eleven small brick Georgian style houses which are Grade II listed. Details include original area railings and steps to front doors. They look out over the attractive green between Gloucester Terrace and Gloucester Place but are separated from it by a wall.



Proposed Design

This planning application proposes replacement of existing timber sash windows at the front of the property. It is considered that these limited proposals will have no impact on the area's heritage value.
