I confirm The Birch tree (1) is growing very close to the mature Scots Pine in the front garden and has a lean away from the Pine and has die back in the canopy. Removal of this tree could benefit the Pine with no serious loss of amenity.

The Pine (2) in the rear garden appeared healthy but a little unbalanced. Removal of the four lowest branches would produce some balance and increase light in the garden /house. The work would not be detrimental to the tree if arranged by a competent contractor without any serious loss of amenity.
