



Approx location and spread of existing Sycamore Tree to be removed – Arboriculturalist advice is that the tree is likely self sown, is bifurcated at 2.1. It has an asymmetric canopy at 8m and moderate deadwood stubs through the crown. The tree is considered low quality and likely causing or adding to noticeable movement cracks in the building at no.98. Ms L Guthrie has been consulted and is support of the removal. See submitted Arbo statement..
