

Key information on 'Estate fencing' as proposed for Warrens Farmhouse:

- 1. Final fabrication of fence will be by hand on site.
- 2. Fence manufactured from steel and painted black.
- 3. Posts have a 'T' cross-section.
- 4. Posts are 1 metre high (subject to undulations in ground and maintenance of level of fence itself).
- 5. Posts are 1.5 metres apart subject to corners and spacing
- 6. The bottom rail is rectangular steel 24mm by 6mm the bottom edge is approximately 24 cm from ground (subject to undulations in ground and maintenance of level of fence itself).
- 7. The second rail is rectangular steel 24mm by 6mm the bottom edge is approximately 47 cm from ground (subject to undulations in ground and maintenance of level of fence itself).
- 8. The third rail is rectangular steel 24mm by 6mm the bottom edge is approximately 71 cm from ground (subject to undulations in ground and maintenance of level of fence itself).
- 9. The top rail is round steel 16mm diameter the bottom edge is approximately 98 cm from ground (subject to undulations in ground and maintenance of level of fence itself).
- 10. The small gate is 90 cm wide by 96 cm high the configuration of the rails matches the fence itself.
- 11. The large gate is 220 cm wide by 96 cm high the configuration of the rails matches the fence itself.

12. The gate posts are round as per picture below.
