Bucks Recycling Ltd Building 214 Hangar 5 Westcott Venture Park Westcott Buckinghamshire Change of use of an existing industrial premises at Bucks Recycling Ltd, Unit 214, from a maintenance, storage and repair workshop and to install a biomass boiler into the building as a renewable energy source. There is one 300mm diameter hole cut into the roof for an exhaust chimney stack and three small holes cut into the rear for water pipes (Retrospective).

Thank you for the above application, which was registered on the 15th June 2021. I also confirm that I have received a fee of £462 (including Validation check fee if appropriate). However if you have engaged with us through the pre-application procedure, I will contact you prior to determination to advise on the planning position.

If I have not sent you a decision by 10th August 2021 and you have not agreed to extend the period for us to make a decision, you then have a period of 6 months in which you can lodge an appeal with the Planning Inspectorate. You can submit your appeal online at https://acp.planninginspectorate.gov.uk on a form available from Initial Appeals, Temple Quay House, 2 The Square, Temple Quay, Bristol, BS1 6PN. We cannot always deal with applications within the period given and you may wish to contact us before proceeding further as, once an appeal is lodged, we cannot determine the application.

We can refer certain types of application directly to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government. I will let you know if this happens to your application. I will also contact you again if, for whatever reason, we cannot deal with your application.

In some cases, we publicise applications by placing a yellow notice on or near the application site. This can be removed after 10th August 2021.
