### 3. Description of Proposed Work

Please describe the proposals to alter, extend or demolish the listed building(s):

The existing pitch roof on the extension at the rear of the property is leaking due to having incompatible clay tiles for the 17 degree pitch of the roof. The roof leaks significantly and is damaging the internal batons and the interior of the house. We would like to replace the existing clay tiles with alluvial clay interlocking tiles that are compatible with the pitch of the roof. This will be a like for like replacement. If this is not acceptable the second option would be to replace the existing clay tiles with a natural grey slates.

The preferred option to ensure no further leakage is to use interlocking clay alluvial tiles as these are guaranteed to prevent leakage. Using natural slate may improve the current situation but will most likely not entirely prevent leakage which is why this is not the preferred option.

The situation is now becoming urgent with continued leakage to the point of needing to catch the water in pans in the front room. Please see the enclose pictures showing the leakage.

Suggested concrete tile replacement would not be appropriate but natural grey slate may be accepted. Since the advice we have sourced an interlocking alluvial clay tile instead of a concrete tile. Natural slate could be an alternative if an interlocking clay tile is refused. However, natural grey slate may not prevent further leakage due to the shallow pitch.
