


Scope of works:

As part of the Colleges Salix funded works for decarbonisation, there are a number of Engineering projects which we seek Planning Permission.

This Application specifically deals with:

- 1. Roof replacement to the Main Building. This will entail the addition of thicker roof insulation finished with a matching asphalt membrane. The original detail is a welted drip bonded to the face of the concrete. It is proposed that this edge detail be maintained with the increase in roof height being managed with a matching recessed drip/fascia.
- 2. Improved roof top access. A new companion stair and bridge are proposed to gain access to the Fly Tower Roof and Oxford Road Wing. To minimise the visual intrusion the stairs have been located within the existing building 'canyon'. Additional roof top plant step-overs will also provide an alternative means of escape.
- 3.To maintain safe access to the Main Building, a raked edge balustrade is proposed and will be set back by 1600mm.




1. Main Building roof replacement and improved insulation: Details

Existing welted drip


1. Main Building roof replacement and improved insulation: As existing




Main Building roof replacement and improved insulation: As proposed







