We have 3 trees directly behind our house. 2 are London Planes and one is a Sycamore.

They are very close and very big and overhang our house. We have only lived in our house for just over a year and are trying to renovate and repair a lot of old damage. The house is Grade 2 listed. The trees have been blocking up the gutters with leaves and twigs for quite some years causing damp and damage to the windows and the walls etc.

After consultation with a number of arborists, we have concluded the best way forward is to reduce the crown rather than pollarding as it changes the shape of

We love the trees and don't wish to harm them, just reduce their foliage overhanging the house and its damaging impact on the house by default.
