




John Chambers Heritage Coastal Areas 80% Grass Seed Wildflower Mix



Sown at a rate of 500g/100m² to supplier's specification.

The site should be weed free. Annual weeds should be controlled by mechanical means or by the use of contact based herbicide. Perennial weeds, for example docks thistle, nettles and couch grass can be dealt with using a translocated herbicide such as Round-Up. Cultivate to achieve a fine seed bed, sow seed mix and then roll to ensure firmness. The best results are obtained when there is good contact between the soil and the seeds.

Mix comprises:

Low Maintenance Grass Seed, Wild Parsnip, Common Knapweed, Wild Carrot, Common Evening Primrose, Kidney Vetch, Common Bird's-foot-trefoil, Vipers Bugloss, Lady's Bedstraw, Oxeye Daisy, Bladder Campion, Cat's Ear, Hound's Tongue, Greater Knapweed, Ribwort Plantain, Foxglove, Sea Plantain, Sea Campion, Common St. John's Wort, Common Toadflax, Common Centaury, Tansy, Thrift, Harebell, Wild Thyme



Grass areas maintained close-mown along paths and around buildings for security and ease of maintenenance



Wildflower grass areas allowed to flower. Mown twice in summer and late autumn. Cuttings removed from site



Hedgerow

Following species planted in double staggered rows, 500mm between rows and 500mm between plants in the rows. Planted in the first planting season after construction. Protected with mulch mats and Tubex tree shelters. All to be 300-450mm bare-rooted transplants, except for the llex which should be 3L pot-grown specimens

Specimen planting of Pinus nigra, 125-150cm, Leader with laterals, 3x, Rootballed.

Footpaths to have a tar/spray rolled gravel finish
