1. Workforce - Based on approx. 12 Subcontractor packages - It is realistic to target a third of the supply chain create 1no. New job each. 2. Apprenticeships - Of the 12no. Subcontractors we believe apprenticeship opportunities will be available within Brickwork and Joinery - 2no. target. 4 weeks based on programme durations, and expected to target both from the Greater Manchester area. 3. Subcontractor spend - based on brickwork and joinery labour package figure. Works have not been fully priced at this stage, this could increase. 4. Job Seekers - hours based on a 2 hour slot per month, 4 weeks based on 1 day per week over. Trial based on 1 month as per standard employment 1 month trial. 24 hours based on 2 hours slot per month. 5. Community Organisations - Based on 2 hours per month, however once the organisations have been decided this will increase.
