TPO BT18/A1 20/8/1975

T1-x1 Large Oak in the garden – to reduce the longer side limbs by approximately 2-3m to reduce the weight and size

To balance prune to make a smaller more compact crown, to remove the major dead and large branches and inspect for safety

T2 – x1 Dead Sycamore affected by sooty bark disease – to fell to ground level

T3-x1 Sycamore next to the above as it has quite extensive dieback in the crown and will likely succumb to sooty bark disease – to fell to ground level

T4-x1 Oak tree (roadside) – to reduce by approximately 2m overall crown reduction to maintain the tree

T5 - x1 Oak tree (driveway side) – to remove the major dead wood and carry out a crown reduction by approximately 2-3m to maintain the tree
