Application 14/01602/FUL - Construction of a two storey side extension - Refused

Application 16/1926/FUL - Demolition of existing detached garage and erection of two storey and single storey side and rear extensions – **Refused**

Application 17/00580/FUL – Demolition of existing detached garage and erection of a two storey side extension and part two and single storey rear extension – **Approved.**

Design Concept:

The proposed application is approved under applications 17/00580/FUL and 17/01857/NMA.

The proposed materials, finishes, window and door styles will match existing to maintain the character of the existing dwelling, established street scene and conservation area.

The proposed two storey side and rear extensions have been designed with roof heights lower than the existing dwelling. By doing so, we have been able to further reduce the scale of the extensions in relation to the existing dwelling, thus maintaining its established dominance on the site.
