

- The service lift shaft and fire escape route have altered much of the historic building fabric through this section and cut away at the vaults
- The eastern wing was an extension built to serve the main hall. New openings and varied floor levels have occ function of the building. It is considered that discreet alterations to suit the change of use will provide less har m to the building in these
- The skylight is considered to benefit the character of the building however it is currently hidden within a false lead roof. It is intended to relocate this at a higher level, reinstating its historic purpose in the building. eiling and concealed with a
- he aluminum skylight appeastern wing. It is proposed ars to be a late 20thC addition, however there is evidence a skylight existed historic to remove this skylight and its steel protective reinforcement bars and replace with storically at the roof level to with a modern glass roof.
- Modern stud partition walls, doors, detailing, false ceilings and redundant service systems detract from the historic character of the building. These are proposed to be removed throughout the scheme.
