- 10 meters. Spread 8 meters. T3 Holly To reduce in height by 1-2 meters. Current height 7 meters. T4 Oak Reduce the over extended limbs growing over the phone lines and road by approximately 2 meters. Crown raise over the road and drive way to allow a clearance of 4 meters from the ground level.
- T5 Holly Reduce the height by 2 meters. Current height 7 meters.
