

SELBORNE SU 79 NE 2/9 Stable and Oast 20 metres west of Wick Hill Farm House

**GVII** 

Stable, with attached oast. C17, C18. The frame is exposed along the north elevation, with brick nogging, the eastern section being boarded: other walling is boarded, with openings on the south elevation. 1/2 hipped roof, oasts roofless. Long narrow timber-framed structure, connected to a pair of oasts at the west (and north) side. The coupled circular oasts are linked to each other, and to the stable by a short wall, the lower part of malmstone and the upper of brickwork, topped by a dentilled eaves band. The stable seems to have been the original farmhouse, hence included for group value.
