<i>Sedum trays will be incorporated onto the retained existing extension flat roof as shown on the proposed roof plan.</i>	A, B, I
<i>A new planting/rockery incorporating areas of water will be included within the footprint of the removed pantry extension to take some rainwater run off and provide further habitat for insects</i>	A, B, C, E, F, G, I
<i>The existing pond will be retained and maintained as shown on the site plan</i>	A, B, C, D, J
<i>A new water butt will be connected to the existing flat roof extension to collect water for reuse in the garden. The 2 existing water butts on the garden room will be retained</i>	A, C, E,
<i>Existing planting will be maintained along the boundary with Sussex Gardens when the fence is lowered to maintain this habitat, and existing mature trees in the garden will be maintained</i>	B, E, F, G, I,
<i>Existing gravelled surfaces within the garden will be retained, and existing crazy paved path will be partially replaced with permeable surface (angular gravel)</i>	A, C, D, E
<i>The removal of the 1960's pantry and incorporation of a lower planting bed within the old footprint will improve the aspect to the rear of the house and the view out to the garden</i>	A, B, F, J
<i>All existing planting in the garden will be retained (only existing concrete steps/paving is affected) so the mature planting including wildflowers will be retained</i>	A, B, D, G, J
<i>The two existing compost bins will be retained to compost waste and compost used within the garden to improve soils</i>	A, G, H
