

## Supporting Statement

6 Moss Street, Paisley, PA1 1BL, Window Repairs,

We would like to include this statement in support of our Listed Building Consent application for the restoration and repair of the existing windows to the building at 6 Moss Street, Paisley.

The proposed works will include the restoration of the existing timber windows on the 3 street elevations of the 3-storey building in the centre of Paisley's town centre which faces onto the Paisley Cenotaph. The windows will be re-glazed with Slimline double-glazed units that have overall thickness of 16mm. The glazing units will be putty glazed to the exterior and the frames of the timber sash and case windows will be re-painted with the external perimeter edges re-sealed with burnt sand mastic.

The impact of these repairs will be minimal as we are removing the existing windows to restore them off-site which will mean any damage to the existing fabric of the building will be as little as possible. The timber windows will also be re-painted in a sympathetic colour in-keeping with the historic setting of the building and its surroundings. This restoration project will also enhance the thermal performance of the building with use of the Slimline double-glazed units while also retaining the existing character of the building with the original timber sash and case window profiles.
