Condition 8: Prior to the commencement of development a landscaping and biodiversity enhancement plan shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The scheme shall include indications of all existing and proposed trees (including spread and species) and hedgerows on the land, identify those to be retained and set out measures for their protection throughout the course of development. All planting, seeding or turfing comprised in the approved details of landscaping shall be carried out in the first planting and seeding seasons following the first use of any of the units hereby approved, and any trees or plants which within a period of 5 years from the completion of the development die, are removed or become seriously damaged or diseased shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of similar size and species. The scheme shall also incorporate the nearby Public Rights of Way which must be clearly indicated on the plans submitted.

Condition 9: Prior to the commencement of development, a Hedgerow Replacement and Aftercare scheme shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The submitted scheme shall include a scaled drawing identifying the location of hedgerow translocation or replacement planting and a written specification clearly describing the translocation method and/or species, sizes, densities and planting numbers proposed, as well as aftercare measures. The approved scheme shall be implemented in full and maintained thereafter.
