

Bracing – Type / Condition	Existing cobra bracing is taught between stems and tight around each stem. Rubber shock absorbing rubber is bulging between nylon weave. Bracing between West and North stems is very tight and previously rubbing branches between West and East stem have moved apart, pointing to West stem having moved towards house number 66.										
Wildlife - Birds/bats	No wildlife apparent										
Summary of findings	3 co-dominant stems from near base. Tree displays wide canopy with multiple over sized long branches which are crossing on occasion. At least 2 large poorly developed and included unions are apparent with upper crown. A number of previously (reported) failed limbs have left large scars on lower limbs and openings within the canopy										
Recommendations	Reduce overall canopy by approx 2meters, back to suitable growth. Replace existing bracing, ensure dating identification is used
