Reduce overall Cedar canopy by approx 2m - Shown circled in orange on sketch plan
Reasons for work: 3 co-dominant stems from near base. Tree displays wide canopy with multiple over sized long branches which are crossing on occasion. At least 2 large poorly developed and included unions are apparent with upper crown. A number of previously (reported) failed limbs have left large scars on lower limbs and openings within the canopy
