T1 -To dismantle twin stem Acacia to ground level and remove arisings leaving stump as low as possible. Mid last week a vehicle struck the tree in the attached photos causing a limb to be removed. Upon inspection, I found that the tree has historically failed at the base (decay evident) and has been dislodged and is now being supported partially by the roots and I believe more so by the wall.

It's a twin stemmed Robinia with basal decay at 0.25m from ground level
