With reference to our previous approved application number 20/06588/CTREE: Crown thinning by 25% and reduction by 3 metres x 1 Silver Birch (T1), we have been advised by the tree surgeon who came to quote for the work (Devey Tree Care) that the tree is not a good specimen, is brittle and has poor amenity value. The tree has always shed small twigs, but in the last 2 years has started dropping larger branches, some of which have fallen onto the glass skylight on our house. Having considered this, and the proximity to our house; alongside the views and comments from the tree surgeon, we are therefore now requesting permission to fell the tree, and to replant, in as close a position as possible, with a young, healthy specimen (according to advice on which species would be most suitable for the position, and potential impact of future root system, given the proximity to the house.)
