How are you? Hope all is well.

We would like to carry out some work within Castle Acre conservation area please.

The applicant is Steve Hutchins and his neighbours tree. Steves address is 20 High Street, Castle Acre, PE322BQ.

The neighbour and trees owner is Anne Loch.

Her address is - 21 High Street, Castle Acre, Kings Lynn, Norfolk, PE32 2BQ. The tree is situated in her garden at the back of the property.

Its a Conifer tree on the boundary of the gardens. We would like to reduce the height by approx. 1-1.5m and do a partial reduction on Steves side back to the boundary. This is to enable more sun/light into Steves garden and to keep the tree to a suitable height/size for its location.
