Pastoral Church Buildings Scheme

This Scheme is made by the Church Commissioners (“the Commissioners”) this 25th day of November 2020 in pursuance of the Mission and Pastoral Measure 2011, the Right Reverend Paul, Bishop of Whitby, duly appointed in that behalf pursuant to section 13 of the Dioceses, Pastoral and Mission Measure 2007 having consented thereto.

PART I

Declaration of closure for regular public worship

1. The church of Saint Timothy, Hemlington (the building), being the parish church of the parish of Hemlington in the diocese of York, shall be declared closed for regular public worship by this Scheme.

2. The marriage register books, if any, appertaining to the said church shall be dealt with in accordance with section 62 of the Marriage Act 1949 and, subject to any provisions of the Parochial Registers and Records Measure 1978 that apply thereto and any directions thereunder, any other register books and records of that church which remain in parochial custody shall be dealt with as the Archbishop shall direct.

PART II

Demolition of the Building

3. The York Diocesan Board of Finance (the Board) shall demolish the building and shall dispose of the materials arising from the demolition.

Disposal of the site

4. The Board is hereby empowered to sell, give, exchange or lease the site of the said building shown edged in red on the attached plan.

5. The net proceeds of any sale or exchange and the premiums on any lease or licence shall be paid to the Commissioners in accordance with section 63 (5) of the said Measure.

Contents

6. The contents of the building shall be disposed of as the bishop shall direct.

PART III

Coming into operation of this Scheme

7. Part 1 of this Scheme shall come into operation upon such date as the Commissioners, after consultation with the bishop, shall determine.

8. Part II of this Scheme shall not come into operation until such date or dates as the Commissioners shall determine following the making of this Scheme.

9. Part III of this Scheme shall come into operation on the date on which it is made.

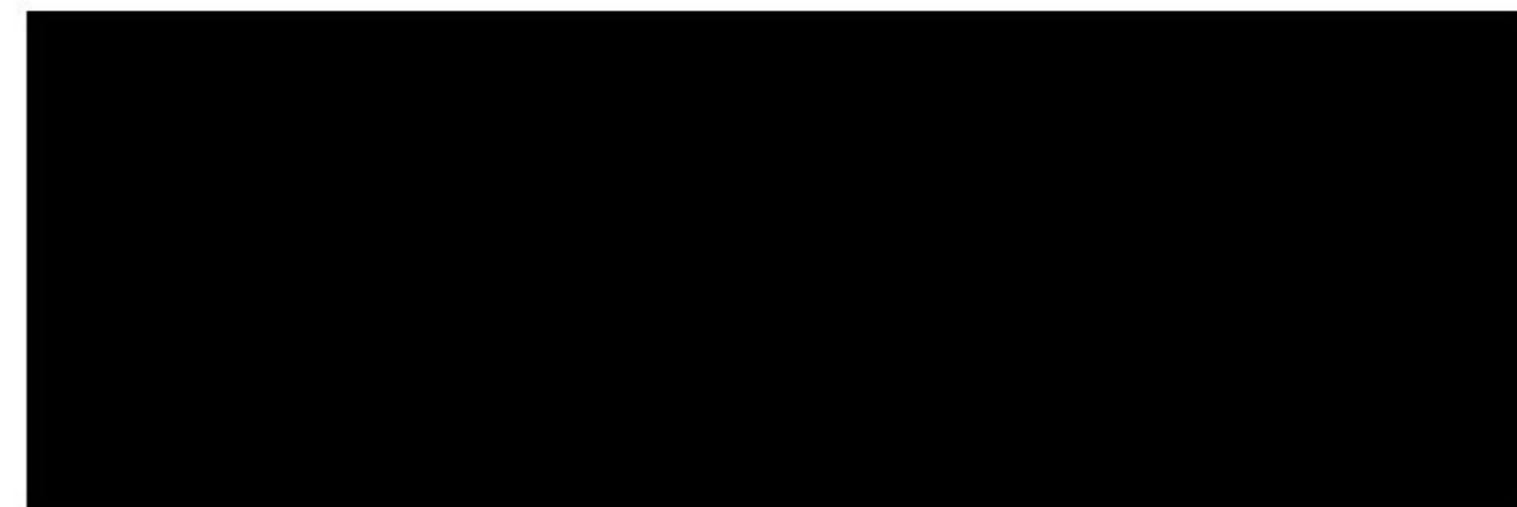
10. The Commissioners shall not be obliged to bring the Scheme or any part thereof into operation until such time as they are satisfied that the conditions specified in Schedule 1 have been complied with but may do so if they so determine.

Schedule 1: Conditions

- (i) That an alternative place of worship has been provided.
- (ii) That the terms of the disposal have been approved by the Commissioners.
