

We would like to crown lift all trees to 6 metres from the ground.

T1 Oak

We would like to remove this tree due to its condition (lighting strike, large amounts of dead wood, poor specimen).

T2 Oak

We would like to remove this tree due to its condition (large wound at the base of tree).

T3 Oak

We would like to remove this tree due to its condition (lower bark falling off, weeping fissures, deformed area on the lower stem).

T4 Yew

We would like to remove this tree due to the excessive shading it creates combined with the larger Oaks.

T5 Oak

We would like to reduce the width of the tree from 8.5 metres by 3 metres leaving a finish of 5.5 metres. This is to keep the tree clear of the house.

T6 Oak

We would like to reduce the height by 3 metres from 18 metres leaving a finished height of 15 metres.

We would like to reduce the width of the tree from 10 metres by 2 metres leaving a finish of 8 metres. This is to keep the tree clear of the house.

T7 Oak

We would like to reduce the height by 2.5 metres from 16 metres leaving a finished height of 13.5 metres.

We would like to reduce the width of the tree from 10 metres by 3 metres leaving a finish of 7 metres. This is to keep the tree clear of the house.

T8 Oak

We would like to reduce the height by 2.5 metres from 16 metres leaving a finished height of 13.5 metres.

We would like to reduce the width of the tree from 14 metres by 2 metres leaving a finish of 12 metres.

We would like to crown lift the tree to 6 metres from the ground to remove the epicormic growth.

This is to keep the tree clear of the house.

These works are intended to remove the damaged and diseased trees, and prevent trees from damaging the property.

The client intends to re plant native species when the area becomes clear.
