The tree has been inspected by tree surgeon Phil Walton who has advised that he would be happy to discuss any concerns you may have or answer any questions. His telephone number is 07515 887427. His advice today was that the tree requires a crown lift up to 5 metres from over the property. The tree has grown towards the property 46 New Road and is significantly reducing the light within the house.
