T3-6 Sycamore Trees x4 reduce to previous pollarding points

T7 Strawberry Tree reduce garden side by approx. 2m
T8-9 Cuppressus + Holm Oak reduce height with to previous cutting points approx 2m off.

T10 Silver Birch Tree reduce branches overhanging neighbouring property to boundary line.

T11 Cherry Tree reduce branches overhanging neighbouring property back to boundary line.

T12-13 Sycamore Trees x2 reduce by 30% overall

All works are part of regular maintenance work that is carried out on a 4-5 year cycle, for which permissions have been given for in the past.
