Silver Birch - We would like to remove this tree. We, and our neighbours, are concerned about how large it has become and the impact this may have on the 8ft Dry Stone Wall it is next to. It also casts an enormous shadow over our very narrow garden, so we would like to get more light into it in order to grow more flowers and shrubs to attract bees. It contains a climbing honeysuckle but we propose to keep that and train it along a trellis.

Unknown Tree - This has been slowly dying for the past 5yrs, but has not leafed at all this year. The trunk looks dead. It sits right outside the master bedroom so we would like to remove it.
