




Typical Landscaping Plan 1:100

Summer Sun Cherry, very hardy variety and produces crops even in unfavourable areas. A good bushy shape makes the tree easy to manage. Fruits are red to dark red, firm and crunchy and have an exquisite flavour. Sets fair crops on its own, but more prolific if pollinated by any other self fertile variety.

History: Developed at the John Innes Centre, Norwich in 1970. Received an Award of Garden Merit from the Royal Horticultural Society.

Ultimate height 2.5-4 metres


Ultimate spread 2.5-4 metres

The best time to plant Summer Sun is in late autumn to early winter. It can be planted at other times of year but will require watering more frequently to ensure it establishes
