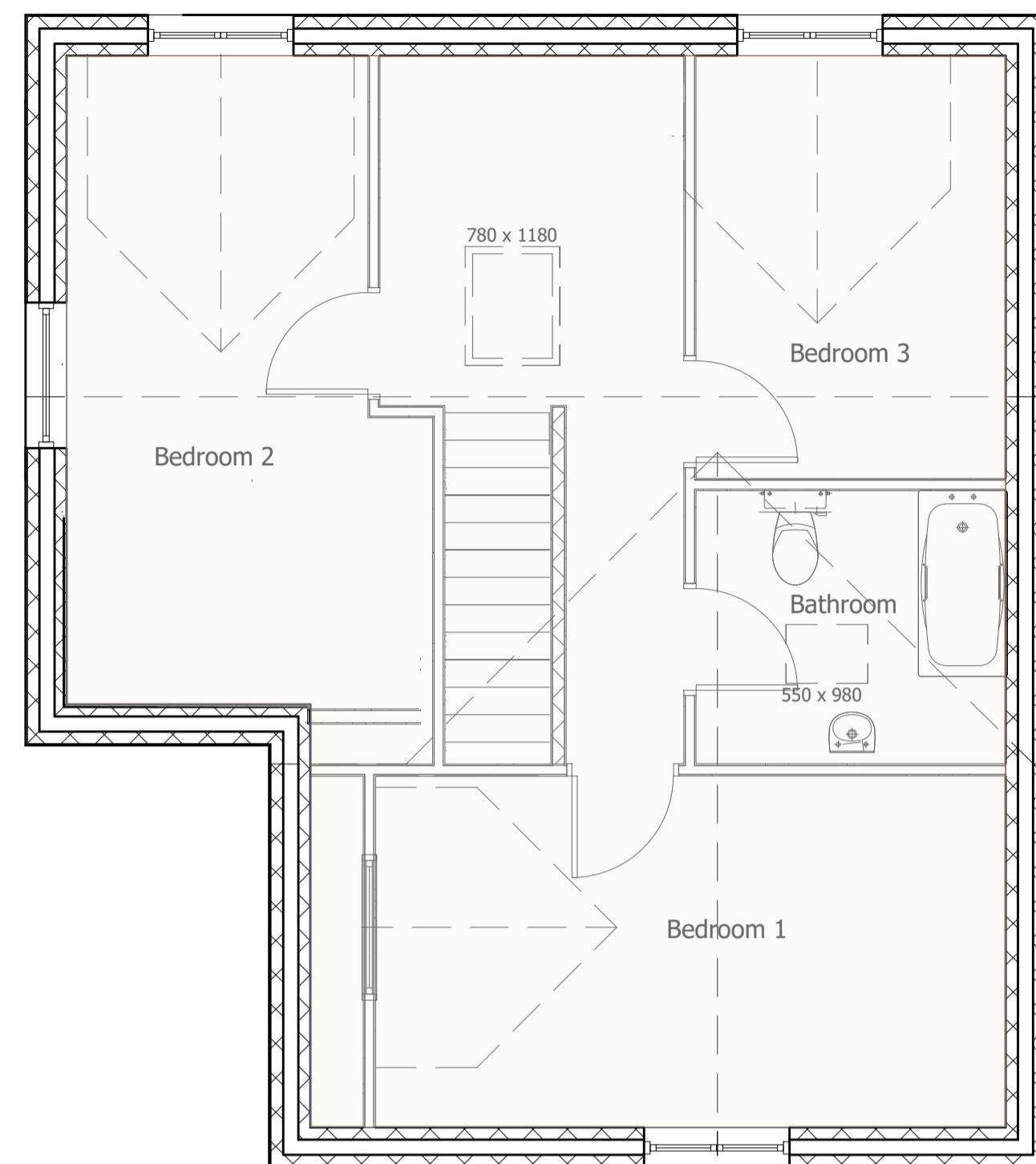
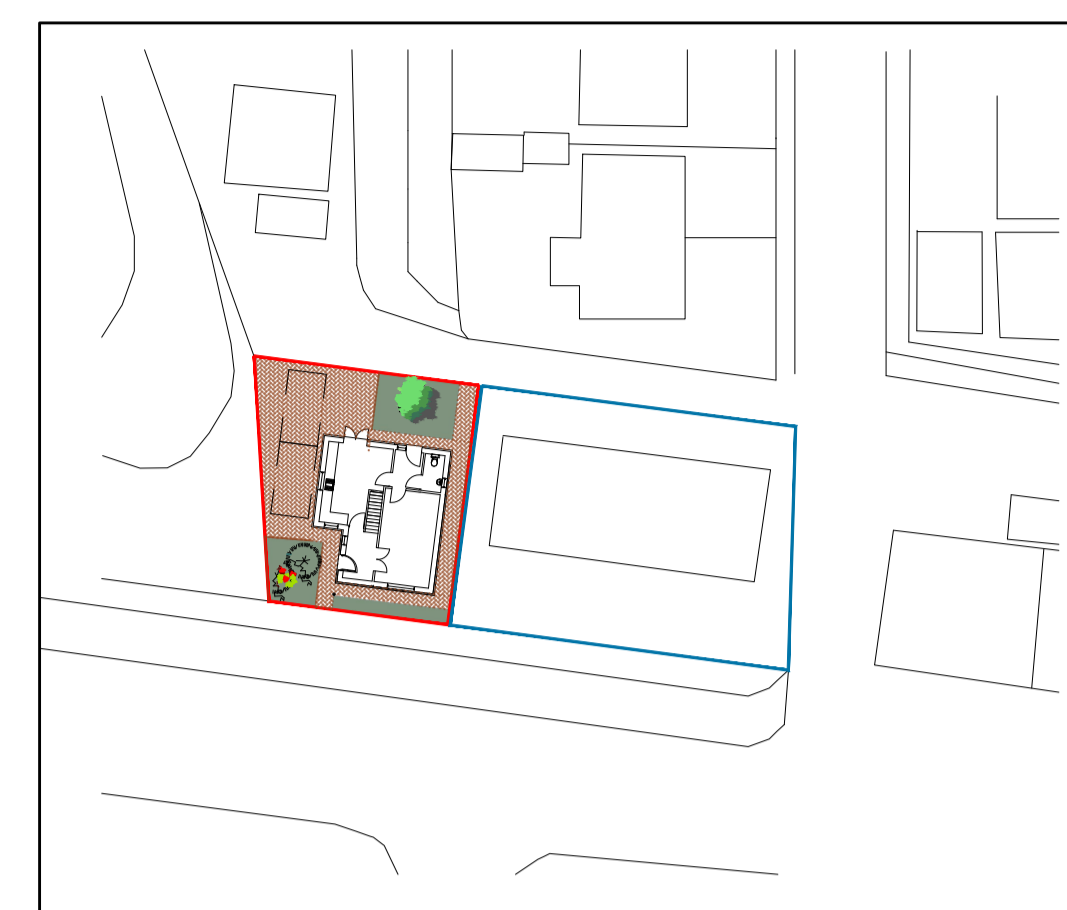


Proposed Ground Floor 1:50

Summer Sun Cherry , very hardy variety and produces crops even in unfavourable areas. A good bushy shape makes the tree easy to manage. Fruits are red to dark red, firm and crunchy and have an exquisite flavour. Sets fair crops on its own, but more prolific if pollinated by any other self fertile variety.

History: Developed at the John Innes Centre, Norwich in 1970. Received an Award of Garden Merit from the Royal Horticultural Society.

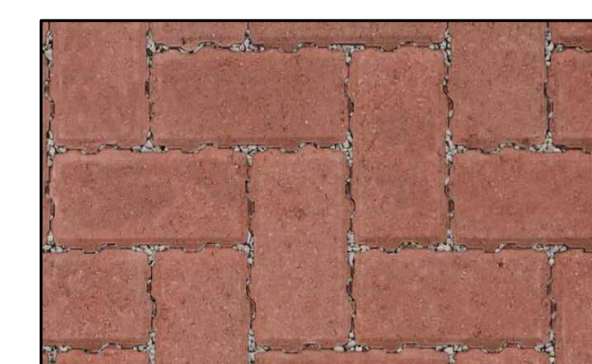
