Description

The Thatched Cottage is a detached cottage with painted masonry external elevation, which originally supported a traditional partly hipped timber cut thatched roof. Parts of the external wall at first floor are of timber frame construction, namely the part gables.

The Thatched Cottage is Grade II listed property believed to date to C17 or earlier, with a substantial internal timber frame. There is a single-storey lean to garage extension to the left-hand side, with a further flat roof single storey extension to the rear right, and two smaller lean to extensions on the rear elevation.
