The Direction

Under the provisions of the Section 101 Agency Agreement between the South Downs National Park Authority (SDNPA) and Chichester District Council effective from 1st October 2017, the above planning application, SDNP/21/03918/PA3O may have a significant effect on the purposes for which the South Downs National Park has been designated.

In consequence, the SDNPA hereby directs that this application shall not be determined by Chichester District Council. The SDNPA proposes to determine it, or deal with the application itself, as the Local Planning Authority for the South Downs National Park.

Reason for the Direction

This is a prior notification relating to the conversion of a large office building in the countryside from B1(a) Offices to Residential (Use Class C3). It therefore has the potential to have a significant impact on the natural beauty, wildlife and/or cultural heritage of the National Park, and on opportunities for understanding and enjoyment of the National Park - the first two purposes of designation.
