Dear Sirs

I have been asked to submit either permission or objection to my neighbour Mr Ajmer Singh 22 Rylees Crescent, Penilee, Glasgow Scotland G52 4DA who has informed me he has applied to Glasgow City Council to have a driveway made. (Copy of letter attached)

I would like it noted that I object to the driveway being made for the following grounds.

- Both my wife and I are over 70 years of age have blue disabled parking permits due to very poor mobility and both in receipt of Personal Independent Payment.
- I have had a Triple heart bypass and still suffer from Angina and chronic heart disease and suffer from severe breathlessness.
- My wife has suffered from Asthma, Angina, severe Osteoarthritis and Kidney problems for many years, she has had a hip replacement and is waiting on surgery for the other hip to be replaced however due to Covid this has been delayed, she is in constant pain and is unable to walk without the aid of a rollator with seat.
- We live in an upstairs cottage flat which my wife struggles to get up and down the stairs and to lessen the amount of walking she needs to park close to the house.
- I have a driveway which I use due to my own health issues (listed above) and become very breathless after walking down the stairs, therefore it is not convenient to park both cars in the driveway as if one of us has to go out the other car would need to be moved and neither of us is fit enough to go up and down stairs and in and out of the cars to move one of them onto the street, therefore it is easier if one of the cars remains parked on the street.
- I understand that I am not solely entitled to park outside my house, however this is done through necessity and not choice.
- Mr Singh's plans for where he would put the driveway would result in taking where I park away and reduce the street parking forcing me to park across the road from my house which would result in adding to the distance I have to walk, causing me further pain, breathlessness.

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- The placement of the planned driveway would also be below my windows and will cause carbon monoxide fumes to rise from the exhaust when the cars is being started or sitting idling.
- This matter is adding to my wife's health issues as it is causing her to become distressed and anxious as she feels if this application is approved it may reduce her capacity to go out.
