




We cannot rely on this (plus I cannot find it) so you will have to chase them and provide it to us.

I refer to your email sent asking were the evidence is, my client advised that he has been informed that a member of the council has reported the tree as in decline this report is not my responsibility, you sent me an email asking for this information as to which i responded advising you exactly what my client as to which you never bothered to respond back to me to advise that you will be invalidated the application, I have advised you the tree is dieing included the mandatory sketch plan required and have never received a response just like the other addresses I spoke to you about yesterday, we are a local company who work closely with the local authority and a little communication would be helpful when dealing with the cities trees, I have written a letter and will forward this email to a higher figure today as I wish to highlight what has been happening and the type of service we have been receiving, we are trying our best as a company to ensure we are taking complete care when assessing conservation areas and tree preservation areas and these responses feel cold, we honestly just want to be able to provide the best service for our clients but we can not do this without at least some form of communication.

As per our conversation yesterday you advised that you do not have the time to deal with complex tree enquiries and you do not have a tree team within the planning department, I also referred to the point that we have found it difficult when clarifying tree preservation orders as you do not have a digital tracking system, I refereed to the TPO list on the internet relating to Hull city council but you advised you did not know this existed so I am worried if this list is actually up to date, as previously discussed sometimes we are waiting 8-10 weeks for a response when clarifying the status of a tree preservation order because it is sometimes impossible to determine using the information online, you advised yesterday that the reason my wait time may have been too long is because complex ones fall on peoples desks and then end up falling through the net.

I can assure you I have the upmost respect and admiration for the Hull city council and all that they do, however as you probably know especially in the current climate the future of our trees is extremely important especially in Hull and it is important that any tree covered by an order is protected and that the correct process is followed when work is required, our companies environmental commitment is extremely important to us and all we want is to be able to at least ensure we can keep our clients updated with the correct and most up to date information.

I have written an in depth letter regarding the problems we have been having along with the evidence which we will post out to guildhall today.

I can not see the application on the Hull planning public access website which I usually refer to for updates, please could someone provide some clarity on this for me please?







